The existence of a parkland reserve at the northern end of the street, which disappeared during the construction of the Inner City Bypass, explains in part the reason for the orientation of some of the residences which 'backed' onto it. More of a mystery is the house numbering lower down the street with its mix of Clyde and Hale addresses (and some apparently with both).

Petrie Terrace west of Fiveways would subsequently be renamed Musgrave Road and the north-south Gov't Road, initially Cemetery Road, would be extended through Portion 315 and become Hale Street

'Bishop's Hill' was an appropriate name for this locale, James Quinn the RC Bishop of Brisbane purchased seven of the Portions fronting Petrie Terrace, stretching from Regent Street to Hale Street. He missed out on Portion 311 which was purchased by Edward Wyndham Tufnell, C of E Bishop of Brisbane.

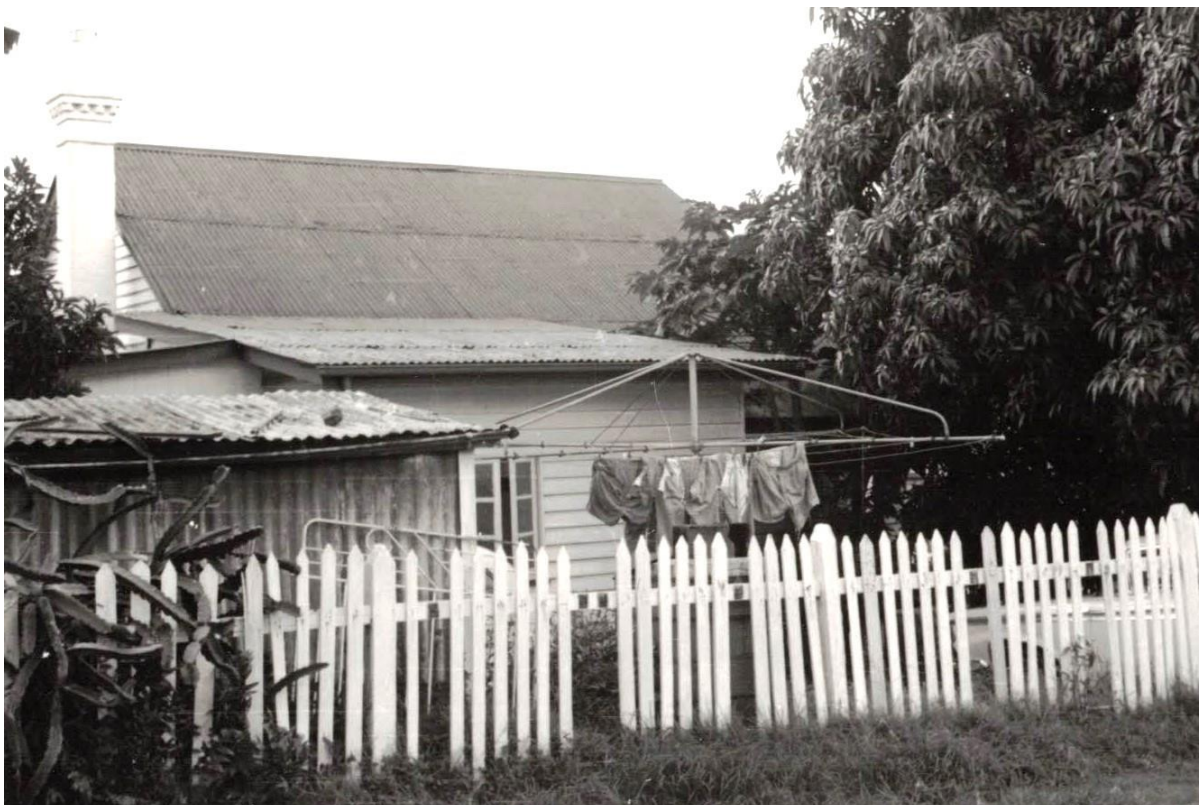

PETRIE TERRACE BOYS' SCHOOL.

The pupils of the Boys' State school, Petrie terrace, held their annual picnic in the Lucinda yesterday. Mr. J. Fihelly, M.L.A., at whose instance the use of the steamer was obtained, was unable to be present, but Parliament was represented by Mr. M. Kirwan, M.L.A. The excursionists disembarked at Woody Point, where, after luncheon, prizes were competed for by the boys, and bathing was engaged in until the departure of the steamer. On the return home, the time was pleasantly spent in singing, and in guessing competitions, the former having been particularly good and appreciated by the parents. The committee and the school staff worked hard throughout the day, and it is to them that the success and the pleasure of the trip are due. An interesting incident of the trip was the singing of "Rule Britannia," and the "National Anthem," as Lytton was passed, and the giving of hearty cheers for Captain Bonham, a member of the school staff, who is on garrison duty at the fort.

This was the home of Michael Joseph Kirwan when he set out on his political career. He was MLA for Brisbane from 1912 to 1932. Born in Maryborough he finished his schooling at Petrie Terrace State School before becoming an apprentice bootmaker. In the 1920s he was Chairman of Committees then Secretary for Public Works, an interesting decade during which the Legislative Council would be abolished.

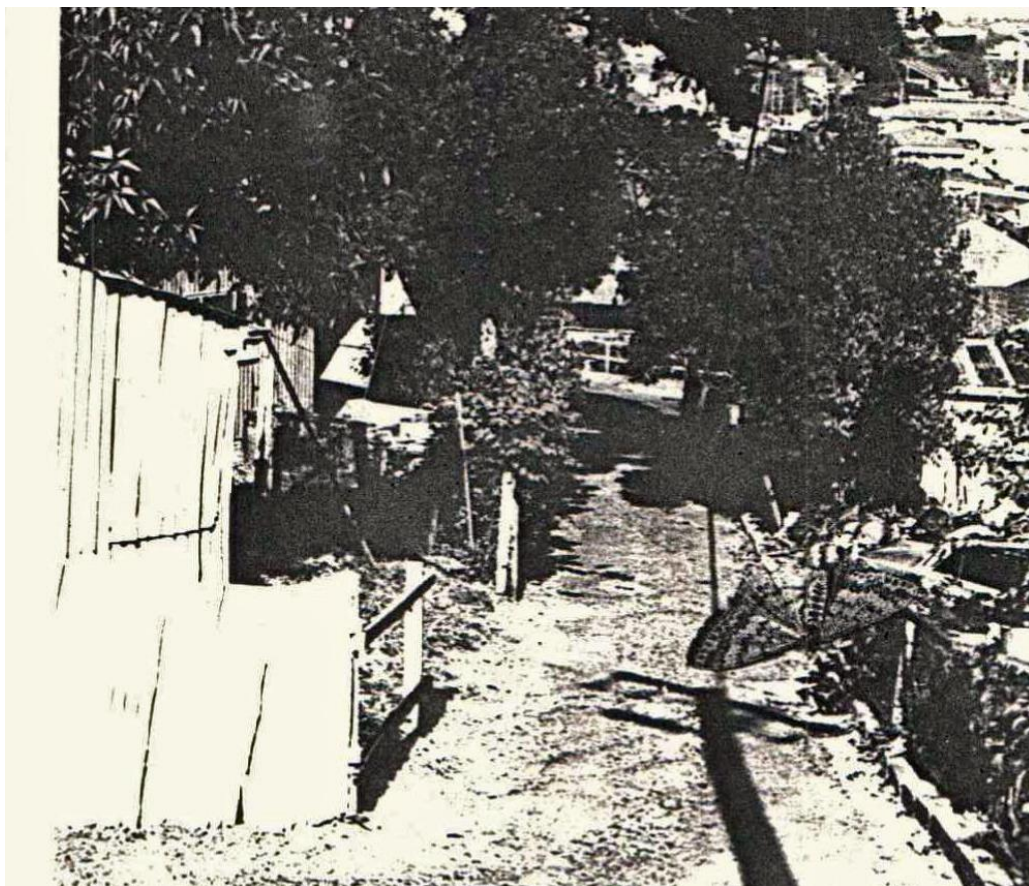

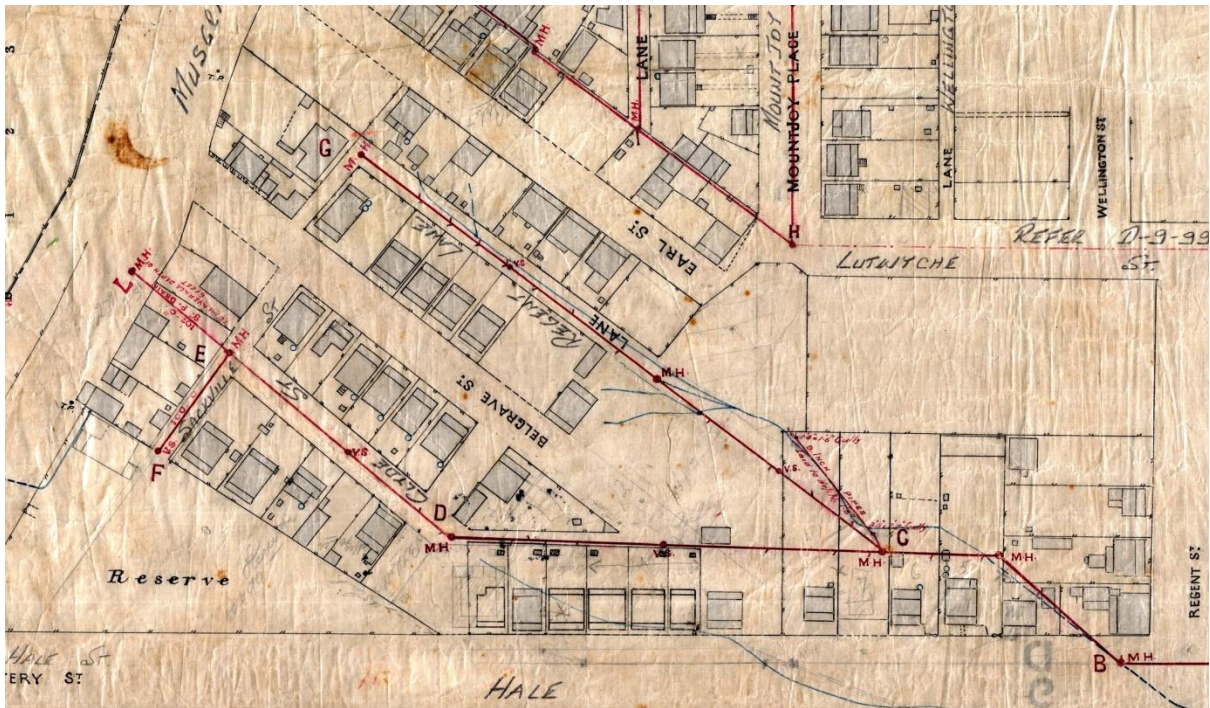

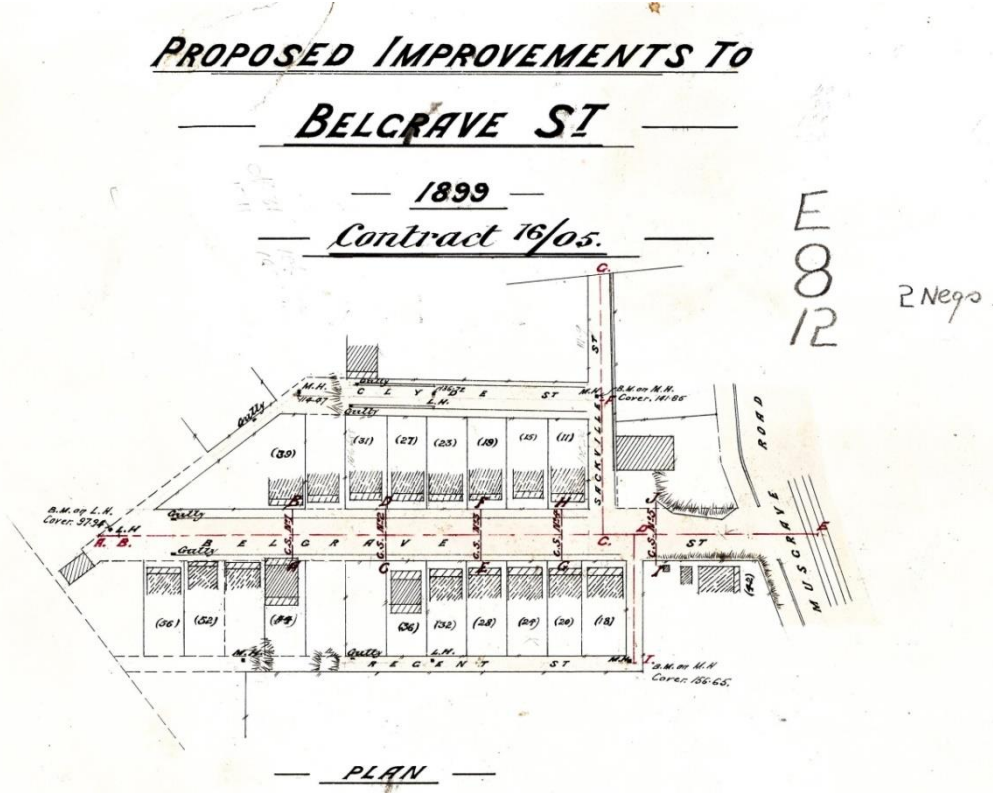

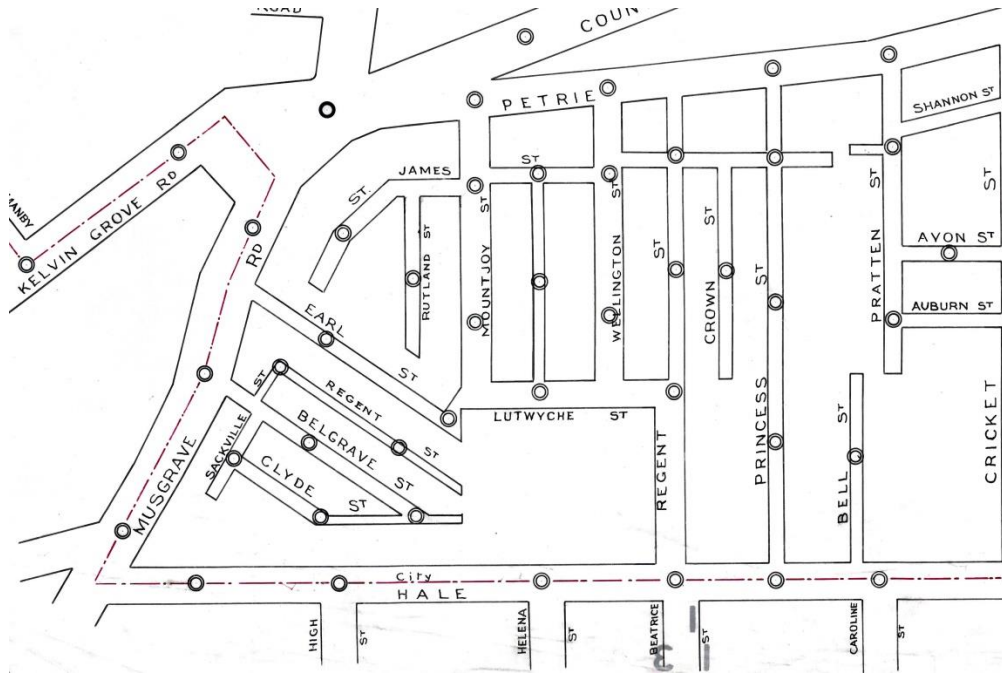

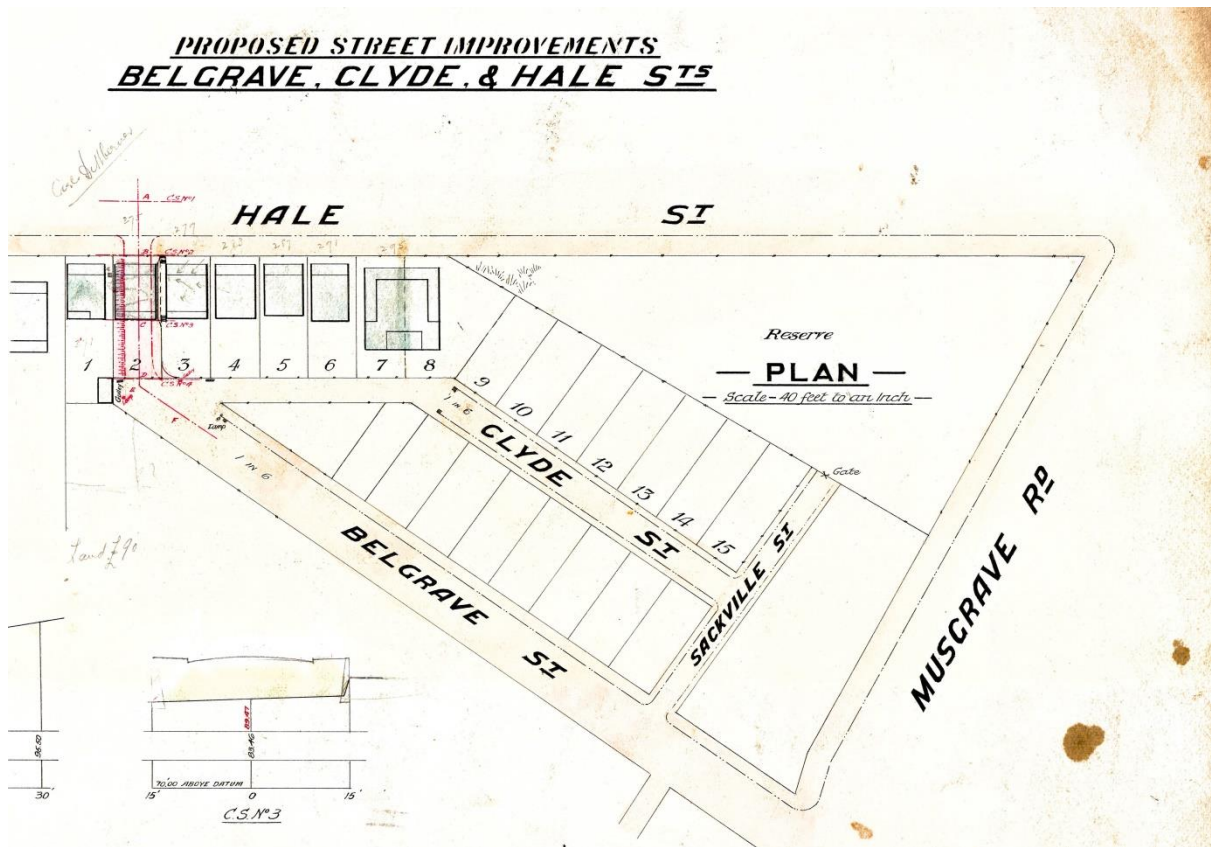

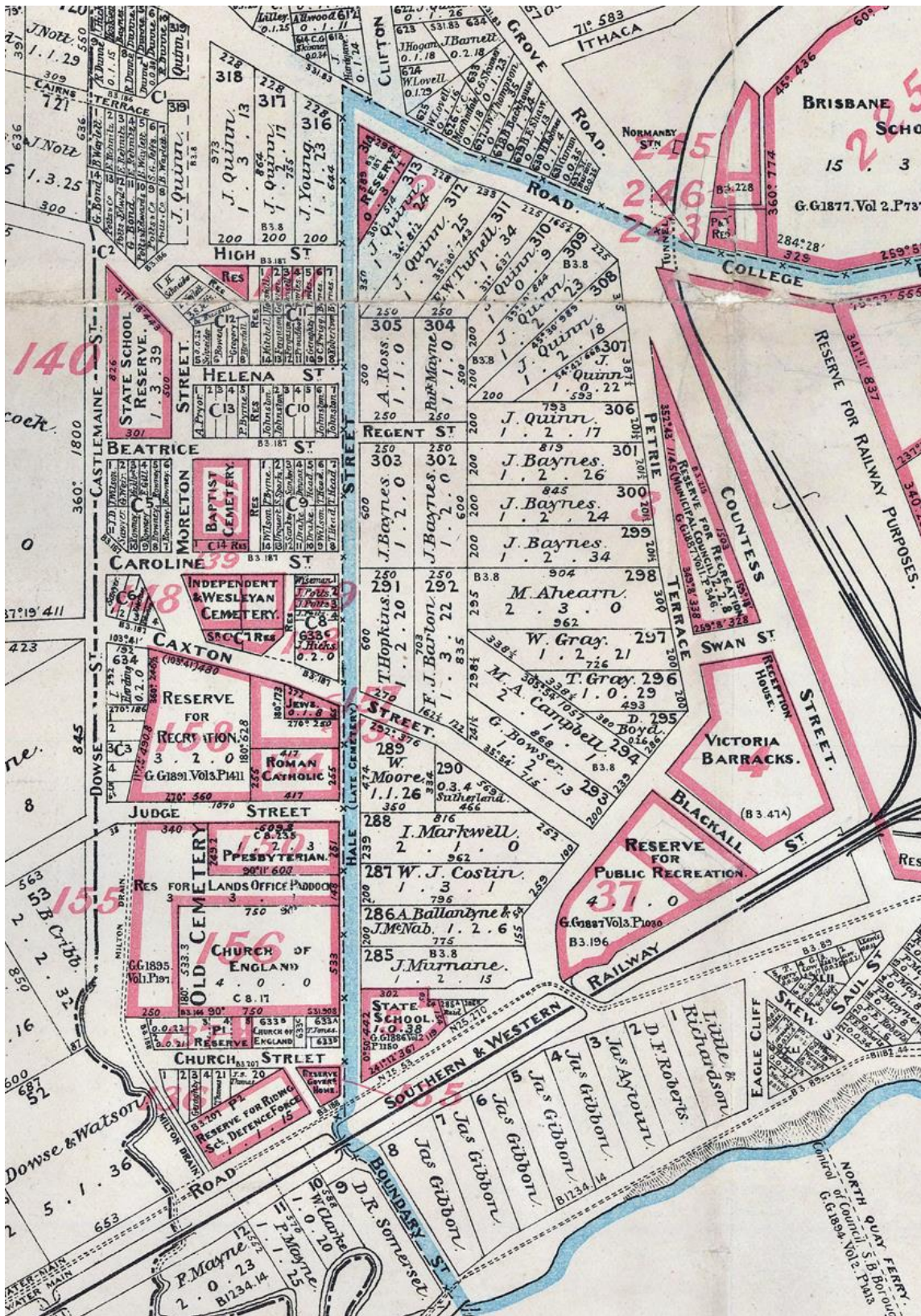
Part 1899 Belgrave Street reshaping Plan E-8-98
